Teachers provide structured guidance and support, offering students meaningful opportunities to develop skills, broaden their perspectives, and strengthen their overall competitiveness.

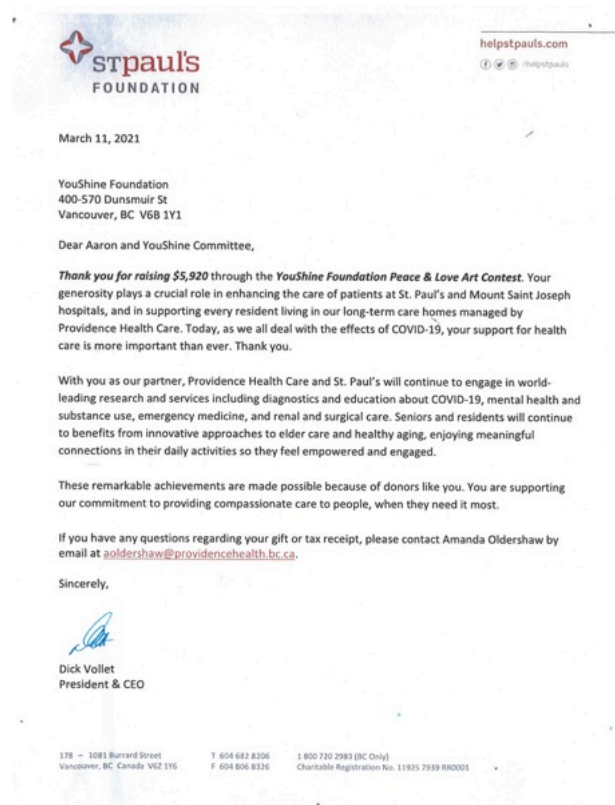

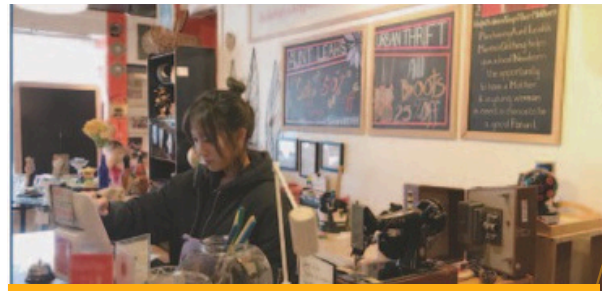

The school offers a variety of scholarships for enrolled students, including:

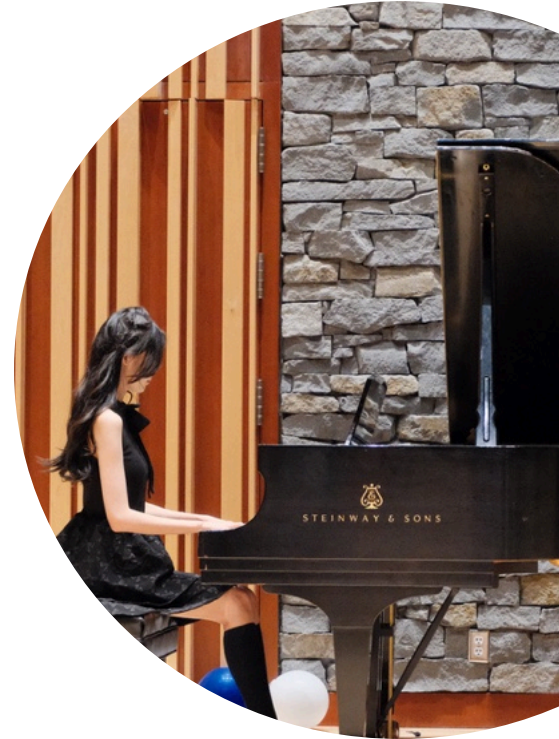
- **Principal Scholarship:**

Awarded to students with excellent attendance (perfect attendance), a positive learning attitude, and strong role model behavior both inside and outside of school.

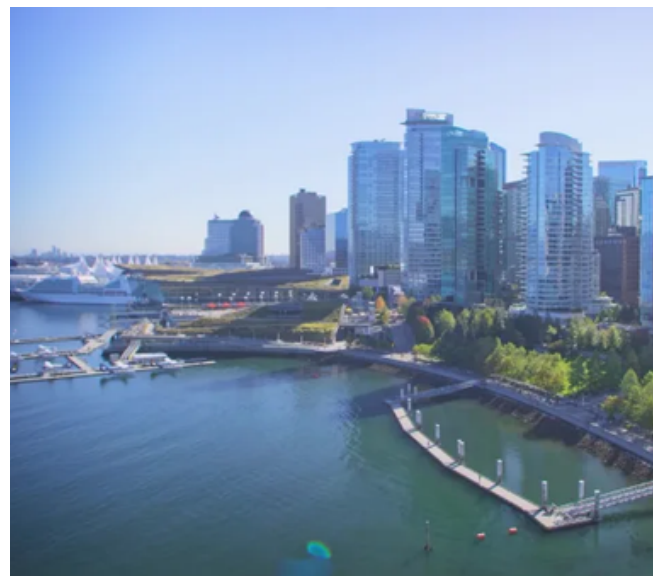

Prime Location with Immediate Access to Urban Resources

Columbia Academy is located in a prime downtown area of Vancouver, next to the Seawall and Stanley Park, offering a beautiful environment and excellent accessibility. It is just a one-block walk from Waterfront Station, providing easy access to all parts of the city.

The surrounding area offers rich cultural and recreational resources, including the Vancouver Art Gallery, public libraries, BC Place, theatres, Robson Square skating rink, and nearby sports facilities. This vibrant downtown setting provides students with abundant opportunities for learning, arts, sports, and real-world experiences.



School Facilities

Columbia Academy operates two campuses located approximately 1,000 meters apart, allowing students to freely access the resources and facilities of both sites.

- **Dining Hall:** A spacious and comfortable area providing a pleasant dining environment.
- **Library Access:** Students have access to the nearby Simon Fraser University Library, offering rich academic resources.
- **Reading Room:** Over 1,000 books, providing a quiet space for study and reading.
- **Science Labs:** Fully equipped labs for Chemistry, Physics, and Biology experiments.
- **Computer Lab:** Modern facilities supporting IT learning.
- **Music Room:** Equipped with instruments for learning and practice.
- **Fitness Room:** Gym facilities with table tennis and pickleball for student recreation.



Physical Development & Sports Facilities

The school values students' physical development and provides professional PE teachers and a variety of sports facilities:



Dance Studio: A spacious area for dance, yoga, martial arts, and overall fitness training.



Community Sports Facilities: Nearby professional courts for basketball, soccer, tennis, and other sports.



Outdoor Plaza: A large open space in front of the school for skipping rope, fitness training, badminton, and other outdoor activities.



Annual Sports Events: The school organizes two major sports events each year, featuring various competitions that promote physical fitness and teamwork.



Admission Process

Step 1: Submission of an Official Transcripts

Students must submit report cards or an official transcript spanning the last two years.

Step 2: Interviews

Applicants need to have an interview with the admissions officer of CA. International students need to send a self-introduction video to the school.

Step 3: Applying

To submit an application to CA and pay the registration fee, if the student is under the age of nineteen, the application form must be filled out by parents or legal guardians. When completing the application form, please indicate the university and major you intend to apply for.

Step 4: Paying tuition fee

After receiving the tuition payment notice, students are required to pay tuition fees and related charges.

Step 5: Letter of Acceptance

After reviewing the students' application documents, the school will issue a letter acceptance letters to qualified students.

Step 6: Applying for Visa

Once the school receives the tuition fees, it will issue a formal letter of acceptance along with a receipt for the tuition payment, which students can use to apply for a student visa.

Step 7: English proficiency test

Upon arrival at the school, students will participate in an entrance English proficiency test. Course placement will be determined based on the results of the English proficiency test.
